## **Getting Started With Your Wormtopia**

Line Lowest Feeding Tray With Moist Newspapers. Add 50% Kitchen Scraps and 50% Fiber. Place More Moist Newspapers On Top Of Food.

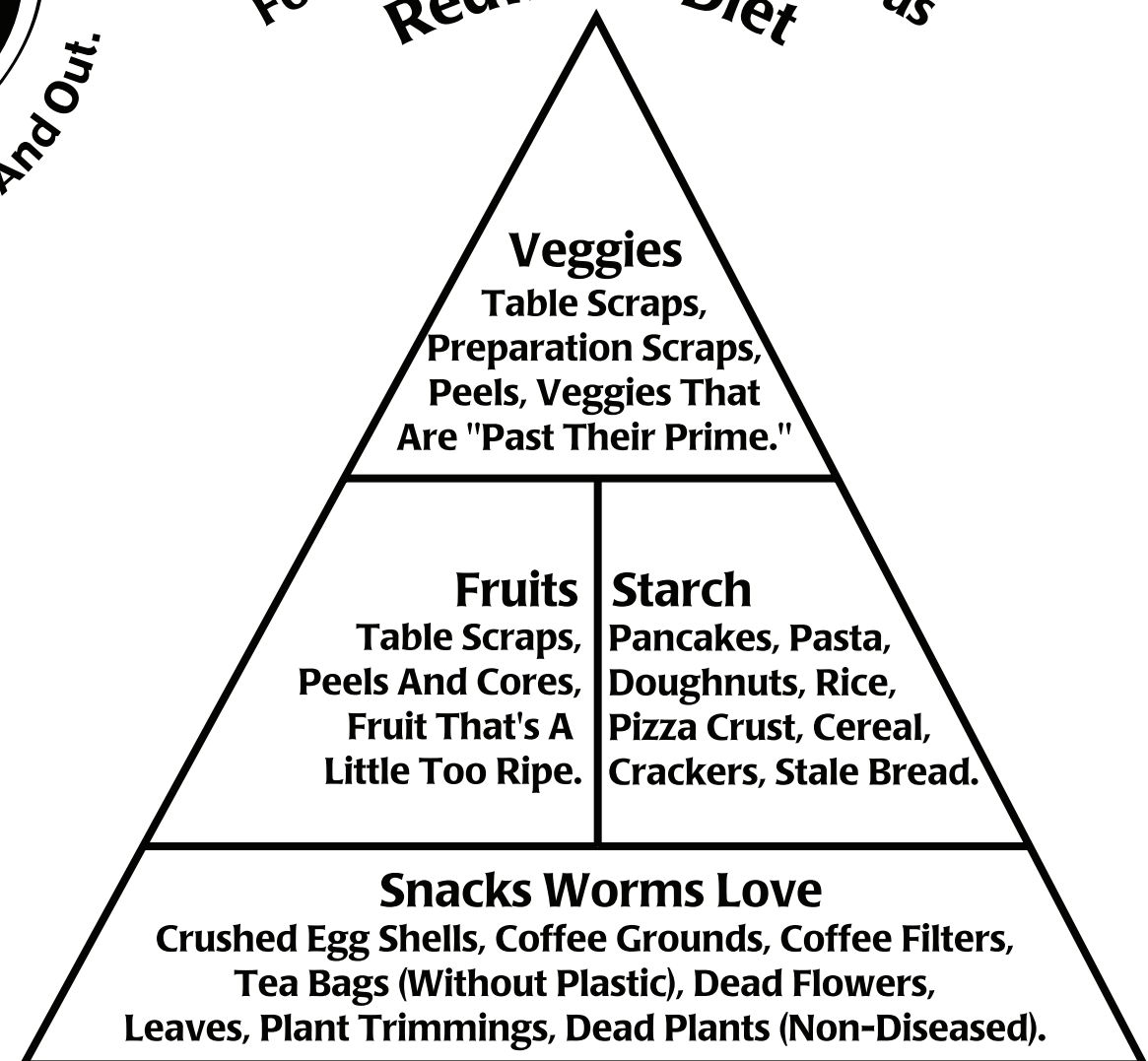
**Temperature:**  
40-80 F. Never Allow To Freeze.  
Keep Dry, Cool and Covered.

**Moisture:**  
Worms Need Moist Bedding. Check The Mixture By Squeezing In Fingers; Several Drops Of Water Indicates Good Moisture. If There's No Visible Water, It's Too Dry, While A Steady Stream Indicates Excess Moisture.

•To **Increase** Moisture: Recycle Collection Tray Liquid, Or Add Wet Fiber, Such As Paper And Cardboard.

•To **Decrease** Moisture: Add Dry Fiber, Such As Shredded Paper, Cardboard Or Coconut Coir.

**Worms Take Small Bites – Feed Them Finely Chopped Food Whenever Possible!**
